•1 POLICY:

It is the policy of the Agency that staff shall not use restraint on consumers in sites directly operated or under contract with the Agency where it is prohibited by statute.

However, contracted inpatient facilities and child caring institutions may establish policies and procedures with regard to the use of restraints. The Recipient Rights Officer will receive and review such policies and procedures for compliance with applicable state and federal rules and regulations.

•2 APPLICATION:

All employees, all consumers.

•3 DEFINITIONS:

Restraint: the use of a physical device to restrict an individual's movement. Restraint does not include the use of a device primarily intended to provide anatomical support.
